

FUEL OUTSOURCING EVALUATION CHECKLIST



SAFETY COMPLIANCE

- Does the transportation service comply with all safety regulations and industry standards related to fuel transportation?
- Are their drivers trained and certified for handling hazardous materials, including fuel?

INSURANCE AND LIABILITY

- Inquire about their contingency plans in case of accidents, spills, or any unexpected disruptions in fuel transportation.

COST & PRICING STRUCTURE

- Compare the costs and pricing structure of the transportation service with other providers in the market.
